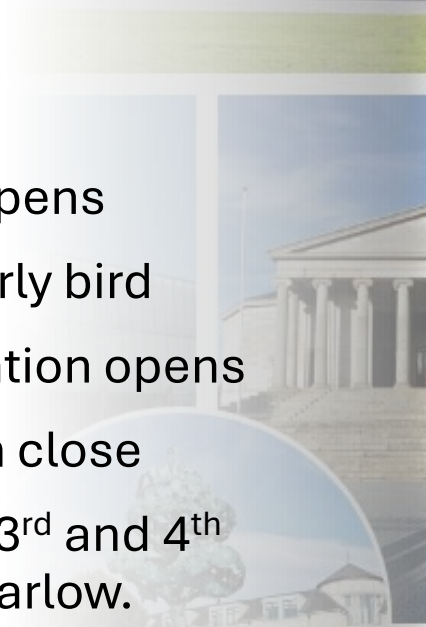

**From Dublin Airport:** take the M1 to the M50. Exit M50 at J7 (**M7/N7 West**).

At Naas J10 take the **M9 motorway south** (total journey time approx. 80 minutes).

**From Waterford:** follow the **M9 north** (approx. 50 mins). Exit M9 J6 for Carlow and SETU.
